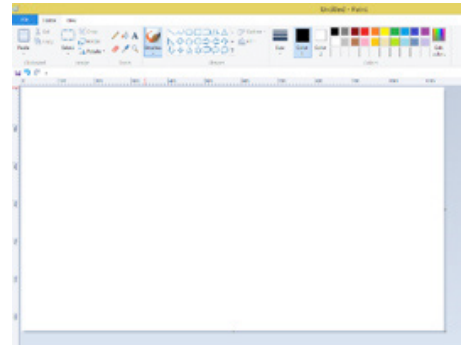


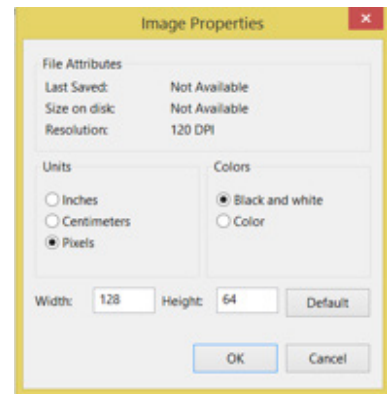
Create a 128x64 pixel image from scratch

1. Open MS Paint



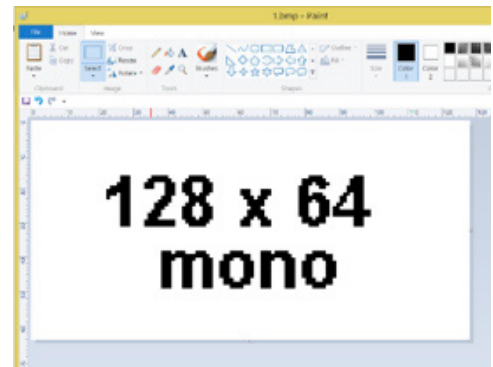
2. Set the image properties

- Click : File -> Properties
- Change Colours to Black and White
- Change units to Pixels,
- Change the width to 128
- Change the height to 64
- Click: OK
- The Image will now change to 128 x 64 pixels monochrome



3. Create your image

- Create your image using MS Paint tools
- You may want to zoom back in by holding the CTRL button and moving the mouse wheel



4. Save the file in the correct format

- Change the file type to Monochrome bitmap (*.bmp,*.dib)
- Change the file name to 1.bmp
- The files must be stored at the top level of the SD card and will be displayed in sequence depending on their file name.
- The names must be in the following format:
1.bmp 2.bmp 3.bmp etc...
